The Health Education and Adult Literacy (HEAL): BCC curriculum and website are a project of World Education with support from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). The HEAL: BCC Curriculum is designed to help adults with limited literacy skills understand and navigate the health care system. Student resources include a 20-page mini-dictionary containing the definitions of medical words related to breast and cervical cancer. The website also includes articles from educators with experience teaching about breast and cervical cancer in adult basic education (ABE) and English for speakers of other languages (ESOL) classes.
